


FROM OTOPENI HENRI COANDA AIRPORT

Transport:

- The Bucharest Metro and an extensive network of buses, trams, and trolleys make getting around easy.
- Henri Coanda International Airport connects the city to destinations worldwide
- If you want to take the **BUS Line 100** from the Airport Otopeni Henri Coanda to the city, you can buy the ticket from the bus by card, the price is 3 lei (ron). Bus 100 runs to downtown Bucharest via Arcul de Triumf and Piaţa Victoriei to Piaţa Unirii, every 30 min, 24 hours a day.
- The **TRAIN** provides a fast connection between Henri Coandă Airport and Bucharest North Railway Station.

 Trains run 24 hours a day, every 40 minutes. The duration of the trip is approx. 20 minutes, and the ticket is 6 lei (ron)
- TAXI Apps: Many locals and visitors use taxi apps like Clever Taxi, Star Taxi, or ride-sharing apps like Bolt and Uber. Most drivers speak basic English, but it's helpful to have your destination written down or shown on a map.
