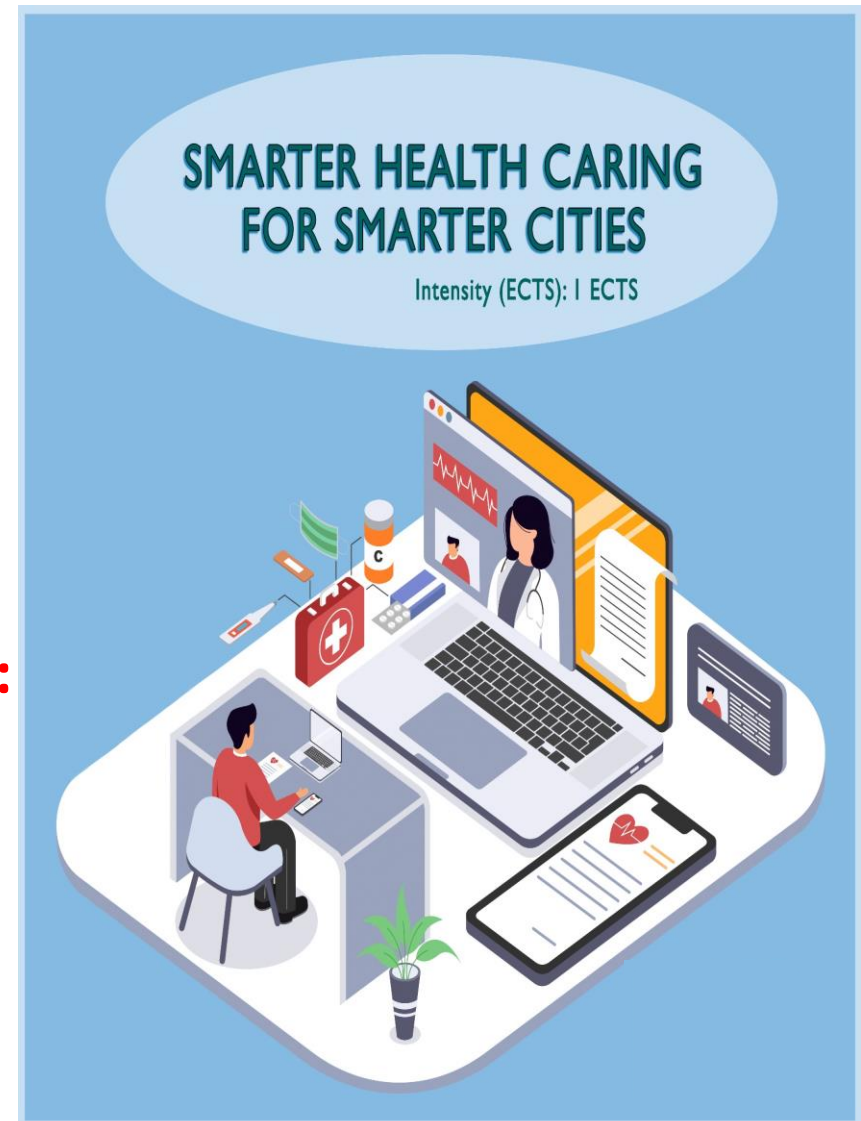

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Title: **Smarter hEalth caring for Smarter Cities (SC4SC), 3rd Edition**

Intensity (ECTS): **1 ECTS. Open to any interested people, students or staff.**

Summary: The course is a **space for dialogue** to discuss possible solutions to unmet needs in health care. **Representatives of all the agents involved in the health ecosystem meet** with students from different specialties (engineering branches from the UPM, and from other universities, other studies). Through a **short series of presentations**, the students and also the speakers will get to know the different points of view of doctors, patients, managers, administration and technology providers. The students, working in small groups, will offer **proposals for the search for new solutions** that involve emerging technologies, which will be initially **discussed with the panel** to refine them through a first round of presentations. These proposals will be **refined and completed offline (TEAMS)** internally within the groups with their mentors, and finally **presented to the panel** in the second round of presentations, with the aim of obtaining well-defined ideas in the form of proposals for new innovation, research or translation projects.





Overarching Learning Outcomes:

- Knowledge of unmet needs in health care,
- Awareness of the applicability of emerging technologies in the health field
- Understanding of the need to use patient-centered methodologies to improve the delivery of medical care.
- Understanding of the need for citizens, with increasing access to information and technology, to be active participants in caring for their health and that of all
- Willingness to propose disruptive technological solutions in the health field
